I am at least eighteen (18) years of age (or my legal guardian is also signing this form below, granting me permission to participate). I know running a road race is potentially hazardous activity that could cause injury or death. I should not enter and run unless I am medically able and properly trained, and by my signature, I certify I am medically able to perform this event, am in good health, and am properly trained.

I agree to abide by any decision of a race official relative to any aspect of my participation in this event, including the right of any official to deny or suspend my participation for any reason whatsoever. I assume all risks associated with participating in the 2010 Exceptional Race for Exceptional People- 5K/1Mile Fun Run in downtown Hillsborough, including but not limited to: falls, contact with other participants, the effects of the weather, including high heat and/or humidity, traffic on the streets, and the conditions of the road, any and all such risks being deemed as known and appreciated by me. I understand bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or blades, animals, and headsets are not allowed in the race and I will abide by this guideline. I understand baby joggers must be heavy duty strollers designed for racing, with a minimum 14" diameter wheel, and all passengers must be secured inside baby joggers. My signature on this waiver and knowing these facts and in

consideration of your accepting my entry, I, for myself and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, indemnify, waive and release the Orange County SEPTA, and the town of Hillsborough, and all sponsors, their representatives and successors from all claims liabilities of any kind arising out of my participation in this event, even though that liability may arise out of lack of action, negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons named in this waiver. I also grant permission for the use of any photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or any other record or likeness of me taken as a result of my participation in this event. I understand if the race is canceled because of circumstances beyond the control of the race committee and sponsors, including, but not limited to, unsafe weather conditions, my entry fee will not be refunded.
